## **Highlights**

- Elizabeth Parker continued to match donations to the Visitor Center Building fund. From October, 2012 to the end of 2018, Friends members and others have donated a total of **\$33,810.01** and the George S and Nancy Parker trust funds have contributed more than their matching share - \$92,860.96, including a \$20,000 match for the \$20,000.00 grant we received from the DNR in 2015.
- Since 2006, Friends members and others have donated a grand total of \$39,847.01 toward building the Visitor Center, making a grand total of \$153,552.97 received for this purpose.
- Design Phase 1 for the Visitor Center (building design proposal by **Dimension IV** of Madison) was completed in 2015, at a cost of \$41,786.11.
- Design Phase 2 (interior exhibits design proposal by **Driftless Pathways**) will cost **\$9,000.00** when complete.
- **Ohio Valley Archaeology** conducted a geomagnetic survey of the site in the fall of 2017, in two phases. The Friends of Aztalan joined the Universities of Wisconsin - Milwaukee and Madison in the second phase, and will have contributed a total of \$6,000 for the project. The Friends received the final report at the end of 2018 and will also receive a copy of the data set, maps, and other graphics suitable for display.
