Highlights

- Total contributions since 2006 to the Visitor Center Building Fund = \$156,806.55. This includes \$43,945.59 from friends, \$92,860.96 from Elizabeth Parker, and \$20,000 from the DNR.
- Architectural Design Phase 1 for the Visitor Center was completed in 2015 by Dimension IV of Madison, at a cost of \$41,786.11.
- Exhibit Design Phase 1 for the Visitor Center was completed in 2019 by Driftless Pathways, at a cost \$9,000.00.
- Ohio Valley Archaeology conducted a geomagnetic survey of the site in the fall of 2017, in two phases. The Friends of Aztalan joined the Universities of Wisconsin Milwaukee and Madison in the second phase, and will have contributed a total of \$6,000 for the project. The Friends received the final report at the end of 2018 and a copy of the data set, maps, and other graphics suitable for display in 2019.
